OVERVIEW

Point of Entry volunteers are responsible for monitoring the number of individuals entering the church for Mass and collecting the contact information of parishioners as they enter.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collect information from all parishioners as they enter the church
- Ensure that those entering the church maintain appropriate physical distancing (6 feet/2 metres)
- Wear the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) provided to them if they are unable to maintain 6 feet/2 metres of separation from congregants
- Open the entry access door and keep propped open until the number of 50 or fewer parishioners has been met
- Open the exit door until all parishioners have excited the church after Mass
- Provide a list of participants to the Safety Coordinator assigned to the Mass

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Ability to demonstrate authority in situations that may be confrontational while being diplomatic and empathetic to the situation
- Committed to ensuring the health and safety of others

COMMITTMENT

Expected to be 2-4 hours per week depending on availability for a period of 6 months, potentially longer

SAFE ENVIRONMENT

- Complete Praesidium Sexual Abuse Prevention online training modules
