It is to be both a physical place and a spiritual entity for the formation and preparation of young Catholics at this pivotal stage in their life so they emerge from the Chaplaincy as committed and equipped missionary disciples.

GUIDING PARTICIPANTS THROUGH EACH PHASE OF FORMATION

FELLOWSHIP

The Chaplaincy will work with on-campus, student-led clubs to build community and relationships.

Students will continue to build these relationships off-campus with SFXC.

Students will grow in their Catholic identity as they learn to navigate school and work.

FORMATION

Enhanced leadership in the SFXC community will provide mentorship during this phase to students and new grads who will be pursuing careers, marriage, and new responsibilities.

Future priests and religious leaders, young couples pursuing marriage, and those desiring social and humanitarian work will develop from this phase.

FAITH

Young couples who have met and married from within SFXC and are beginning a family will be mentors to younger participants.

This phase will guide participants in deepening their spiritual life and prepare them to bring this experience into their professional lives and future parish communities.



PILLARS SUPPORTING THE PHASES OF FORMATION

LITURGICAL LIFE & PRAYER

- Sunday Mass and weekday Masses
- Reconciliation
- Special celebrations on important liturgical feast days
- Seasonal retreats/missions
- Spiritual direction with the chaplain and other approved and available spiritual directors
- Devotions (Divine Mercy novena, Marian months, Outdoor Way of the Cross, local pilgrimages)



SOCIAL ENGAGEMENT

- Fellowship after Sunday Mass each week
- Monthly community building activities outside of the physical chaplaincy centre
- Formal dinners and dances
- Men's/women's nights with corresponding formation and recreation

INTELLECTUAL & SPIRITUAL FORMATION

- Faith group studies (Catholic Christian Outreach "CCO" alumni)
- Instruction and preparation for those seeking to enter the Church (RCIA)
- Lecture series & Catechetical series
- Ongoing summer formation for seminarians (under direction of the chaplain/vocation director)
- Visits from various religious communities / third order lay representatives sharing their charism



APOSTOLIC OUTREACH

- Ongoing involvement in diocesan initiatives
- Service projects caring for the poor/disadvantaged
- Mission trips, close to home and abroad
- Organizing available Chaplaincy members for support (by request) of city-wide, parish-based initiatives
- Mobilization of CCO alumni for professional development
- Outreach to upcoming high school grads promoting the Chaplaincy
- Mentorship of younger Chaplaincy participants
- Assistance and training in preparing personal testimonies; facilitating sharing in other settings
