

SURPLUS FUNDS REQUEST FORM

The TIA Surplus are any funds your parish raises over your TIA Goal. The surplus for 2021 will be distributed to local agencies and food banks within the Diocese.

Surplus Funds Guidelines

The surplus allocation options that we had in previous campaigns will change for this year:

- Parishes will direct how the surplus funds will be allocated (see How to Allocate Surplus Funds)
- Notify parishioners where any potential surplus funds are to be directed in bulletins and/or pulpit announcements
- Complete and submit the required form along with supporting documents by the April 30th deadline

How to Allocate Surplus Funds

The following outlines how surplus funds will be allocated:

1. Local Charities

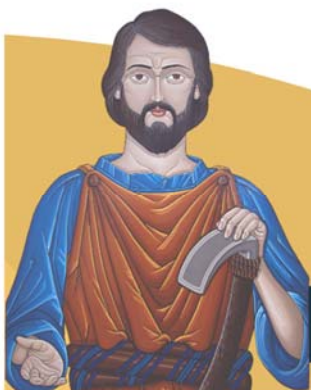
Surplus funds can be directed to local charities from the 2020 agencies TIA allocation list. Funds allocated to these agencies must not exceed the 2020 approved allocation. To do so, the charity / program must be part of the 2020 organizations that did not receive funding. The Pastoral Centre will confirm with the agency if they are still in operation and if they are willing to receive the funding with the condition that funding will be distributed in January 2022 and is also dependent on the collection. Parishes are to select a maximum of three agencies.

2. Local Food Banks

Surplus funds can also be directed to local food banks, but the organization will require a Charity # and must complete an application so it can be approved by the Diocese. Funds can also be designated to established parish food banks. Funds cannot be allocated to the Feed the Hungry Program.

3. Excess Funds

For any parishes who have exceeded their goal but have not requested the return of surplus and have not designated an agency, the Diocese will use these funds for the allocation of Option 1 or 2. If there is an excess of funds at the end of the campaign, funds will be disbursed to food banks within the Diocese.

1. Complete this form

3. Email this form to development@calgarydiocese.ca by the deadline of **April 12, 2021**
4. Include copies of bulletin and / or pulpit announcements informing parishioners of how any potential surplus funds will be directed and to the organization or agency
5. **Note:** Without these copies requests will **NOT** be processed.
6. **Note:** *TIA contributions are designated gifts, and in order for them to be reallocated the Canada Revenue Agency requires donors to be informed.*
7. If you surpass your campaign goal, surplus funds will be directed to the proposed organizations or agencies. (if you have any questions about this, contact the TIA Coordinator)
