

Masks Required



All persons entering or remaining in these premises must wear a mask or face covering that covers the nose, mouth, and chin as required pursuant to Town of Banff Bylaw 436.

This Bylaw **does not apply to a person who needs to temporarily remove their mask to consume food or drink**, provided they are able to maintain a distance of at least two metres/six feet from anyone not members of the same household or cohort. Wear the mask when entering, leaving and moving around this establishment.

Exceptions include **children under two years of age**, or a child who is under five (5) years of age chronologically or developmentally and who refuses to wear a Mask and cannot be persuaded to do so by their caregiver; or **people who cannot wear a mask for underlying medical reasons or disability** which inhibits their ability to wear a face covering. Proof of a medical condition is not required.



Wearing a mask or face-covering does not replace the need to maintain a 2 metre/6 feet distance from others, and practice regular hand washing and sanitizing.
