The Diocese of Calgary was made aware of a historical case of sexual abuse by a religious priest who served in St. Patrick's Parish, Lethbridge from 1963 -1970. The priest is now deceased.

Father John "Jack" McCann, OMI, a priest of the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate, was convicted in 1992 of committing sexual offences against two girls who were minors. The incidents occurred at parishes in British Columbia in the 1970s.

We are unaware of any allegations coming forward to the Diocese of Calgary. If there are victimsurvivors, we encourage you to report to the
