

## ROSARY

While praying the rosary, the Church encourages us to meditate on God's plan for saving the world by sending his Son as our Saviour. This is done by reflecting on the "mysteries" or events of the life of the Lord Jesus.

### *Joyful Mysteries* (Monday and Saturdays)

- **Annunciation of our Lord**  
See Luke 1.26-38, John 1.1-14, Hebrews 1.1-4
- **Visitation**  
See Luke 1.39-56
- **Birth of our Lord**  
See Luke 2.1-20, Matthew 2.1-14, Galatians 4.4-7
- **Jesus is presented in the temple**  
See Luke 2.22-38
- **Jesus is found in the temple**  
See Luke 2.41-52

### *Sorrowful Mysteries* (Tuesdays and Friday)

- **Agony of Jesus in the garden**  
See: Matthew 26.36-56, Mark 14.32-52, Luke 22.39-53, John 18.1-11
- **Jesus is scourged**  
See: Matthew 27.20-26, Mark 15.6-15, Luke 23.13-25, John 18.38-19.1
- **Jesus is crowned with thorns**  
See: Matthew 27.27-30, Mark 15.16-20, John 19.2-7
- **Jesus carries his cross**  
See: Matthew 27.31-33, Mark 15.20-22, Luke 23.26-32, John 19.17
- **Jesus is crucified**  
See: Matthew 27.34-56, Mark 15.23-41, Luke 23.33-49, John 19.18-37

***Glorious Mysteries*** (Wednesday and Sunday)

- **Jesus is raised from the dead**  
See: Matthew 28.1-10, Mark 16.1-18, Luke 24.1-12, John 20.1-10
- **Jesus ascends into heaven**  
See: Mark 16.19-20, Luke 24.50-53, Acts 1.9-11
- **Jesus sends his Spirit upon the Church**  
See: John 16.4-15, Acts 2.1-12
- **Mary is assumed into heaven**  
See: 1 Corinthians 15.20-26 or 15.54-57, Revelation 12.1-5
- **Mary is crowned queen of heaven**  
See: Luke 1.46-55; Revelation 12.1-5

***Luminous Mysteries*** (Thursday)

- **Jesus is baptized in the Jordan**  
See: Matthew 3.13-14, Mark 1.9-11, Luke 3.21-22, John 1.29-34
- **The Manifestation at Cana**  
See: John 2.1-12
- **Jesus proclaims the Reign of God (...and calls to Conversion)**  
See: Matthew 4.12-17, Mark 1.14-15, Luke 4.14-15  
also: Matthew 9.2-8, Mark 3.3-13, Luke 7.47-48, John 20.22-23
- **Jesus is transfigured**  
See: Matthew 17.1-8, Mark 9.2-8, Luke 9.28-36, 1 Peter 1.16-18
- **The Institution of the Eucharist**  
See: Matthew 26.26-29, Mark 14.22-26, Luke 22.14-23, John 13.1-17,  
1 Corinthians 11.23-26
